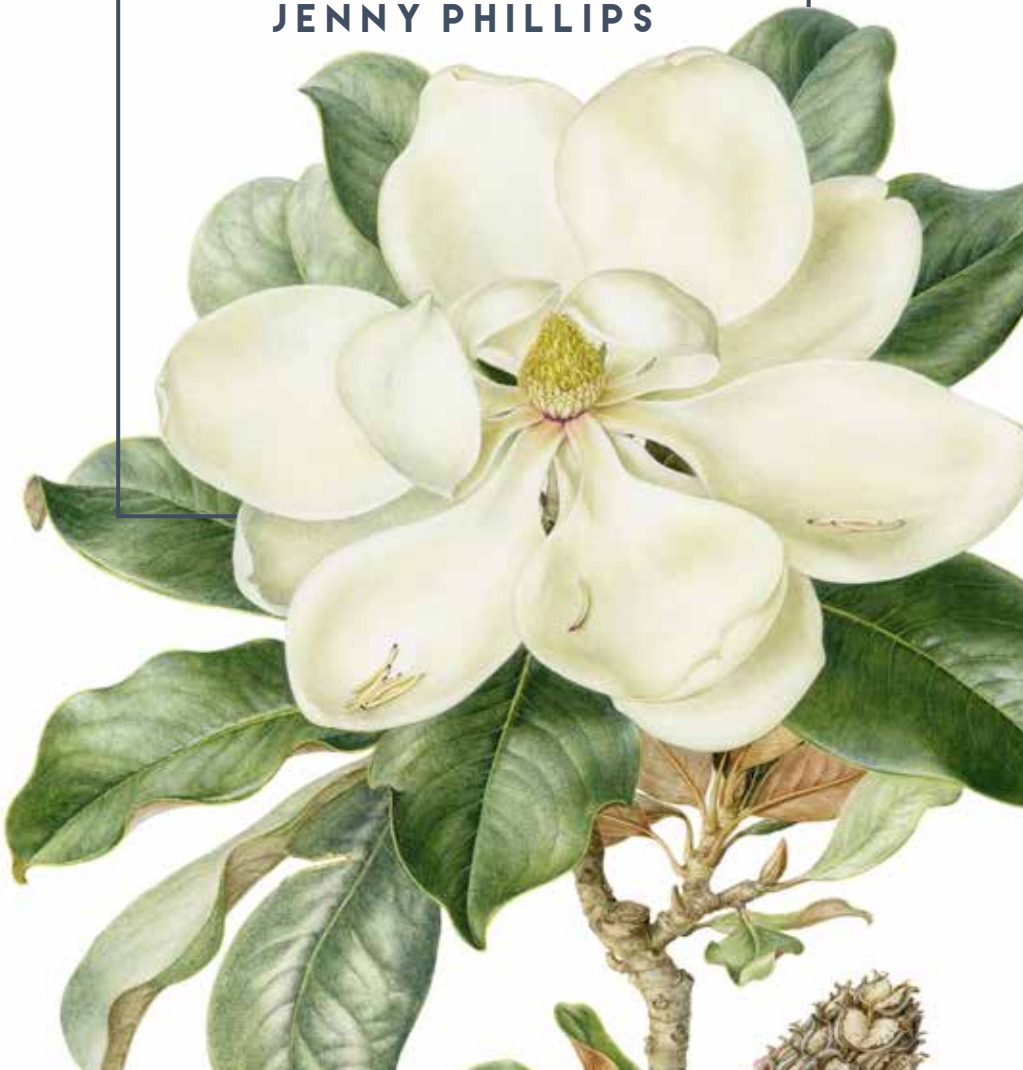

COURSE GUIDE

Tuesday Morning & Friday Afternoon

You will be given a range of drawing exercises to help you loosen up and for me to see where I need to focus my lessons. Subject material will be provided, unless you are otherwise directed to select something to bring along to class. For a start, it is best if we all do the same subject. It's a great way to learn when you see different results and work from different minds.

Tuesday Afternoon, Friday Morning & Saturday

Evergreen Magnolia will form the focus of our attention. It is a great time of year as they are in full bloom and amazing to paint. We will approach the same plant from a number of angles, using a range of media. Subject material will be provided unless you are otherwise directed to select something to bring along to class.

NOTES

Class sizes are limited to a maximum of 13 per session (plus teacher) due to Covid-19 restrictions. Enrolments are on a first-in-first-served basis.

The room will be deep cleaned between each class and Hand sanitiser is ready at the door. Masks are required indoors and outdoors currently. Sanitiser will be supplied.

The room opens 30mins before class start time.

Beginners means people with limited drawing or painting skills and have not done any Botanical art lessons or painting.

New students are people who may have done some or even years of Botanical art, painting and or drawing, but have never been in my classes.

LOCATION

1A Shipley Street, South Yarra (on the left corner of Punt and Shipley Street)

DIRECTIONS

We are between Domain Road and Toorak Rd, when travelling south from the river.

Bus along Punt Rd from Hoddle St stops right near the house.

Tram 58 going along Toorak rd, stops at the bottom of the hill 100 yards away.

Then just lug your materials up the Punt Rd Hill from Toorak Rd corner and stagger into class! No, it's not that bad and probably very good for us all.

Saturday mornings you shouldn't have any problems with car parking as there is a carpark Opposite the house on corner of Shipley Street and Punt Road.

The workers who park there through the week, are away on Saturdays thank goodness.

Enter the property via the gate on the Punt Rd. corner of the building and wander up the garden path. Amidst the plants waiting to be planted, you will see a back door. There is a bell hanging on the right. The door will be unlocked and I will be in the classroom to the left when you ring and enter.

If for some reason! If you have any problems getting through the gate, ring the front doorbell at the top of the front doorsteps in Shipley Street and or call.
